C. Resolution authorizing purchase of a demo Global V6 street sweeper through Sourcewell for approximately \$370,000 approved.

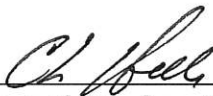
A motion was made by Ken Sockwell and seconded by Gina Clark. Motion passed unanimously.

Closing Remarks

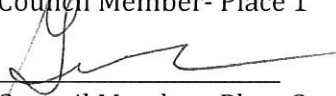
Board vacancies for the Board of Education and Utilities Board were announced. Council members thanked Sports Facilities Companies, city staff, and attendees.

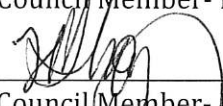

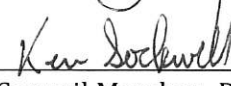
Council Member- Place 1



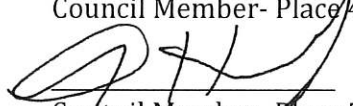
Council Member- Place 2

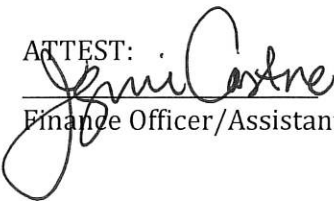

C. Allan Rice and Eric Sullivan

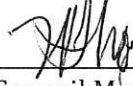
Presented an updated phased Sportsplex proposal, discussed project costs, comparable facilities, economic impact, recreational programming, and answered council questions.



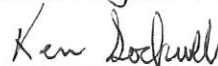

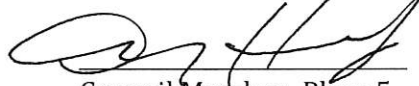
